Question 1: Can proposals be based on a man hour unit cost instead of the per acre unit cost specified in the RFP?

Answer 1: For comparison against prior contracts and current proposals the District is requiring that proposals be based on a per acre unit cost.

Question 2: Can the contractor take sweepings and solid materials to their site?

Answer 2: The Service Provider shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, rules, ordinances, and orders in providing the Services, including appropriate and lawful disposal of any sweepings and solid materials generated during performance of the work.

LCWMD retains the sole discretion to allow an alternative use, or means of disposal other than that identified in the RFP, for sweepings and solid materials that may be proposed by a potential service provider. For LCWMD to consider a proposed alternative use, or means of disposal other than that identified in the RFP, for sweepings and solid materials the LCWMD would require, at a minimum, assurances of proper use or disposal at the alternative location, as well as an asset-backed indemnification agreement related to any alternative use or means of disposal other than that identified in the RFP.

Proposed unit prices should be based upon the disposal procedures identified in the RFP. The proposer may also include an alternative proposal and alternative unit price based on the alternative proposal. Proposals not addressing the disposal procedures identified in the RFP may be rejected.
